Mrs. Penniman,

Attached is a drawing showing potential phase one tree planting locations as well as options for tree selections. This is what I sent to Bryan for use in the grant application.

Pages 1&2 are the same drawing split into two sections so that it can be printed on 8.5x11. I would recommend having a few copies of that but just emailing the main drawing to everyone so they can view it on their own devices.

Its very important to note that we are not tied to any one species at this time, only the number of trees and general description such as "2 large shade trees." Nor are we tied to the main preliminary tree list, this is only to spur discussion and illustrate that the overall scheme will still contain some non-native trees that the council has favoured such as crape myrtles and cherries.

At this time I am not able to provide a proposal for additional services based on a percentage of the construction costs. This doesn't work with the grants; I can only work on grant funded projects at an hourly rate. There are just too many moving pieces. I will call to follow up.
