



Draft Meeting Minutes

Facilities Committee, Irvington Town Council

Thursday, April 2, 2026, at 4:00 pm at the Town Office

In attendance: Committee - Sam Van Saun, Wayne Nunnally, Phil Robinson, Other - Mayor Julie Harris

Old Business:

Reviewed and discussed recommendations in the Green Infrastructure Action Plan developed by the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay. The committee agreed to hold off on recommendations for now, and instead have a conversation with VDOT about the possibility of tapping into the stormwater sewer line that runs under King Carter Dr to solve the stormwater issue on the Commons. This is a priority for the committee this year.

New Business:

Storage for Christmas decorations - The town clerk has secured storage units to house current and new Christmas decorations in the short term. The Committee agreed to work on a long-term storage solution and make it a priority for 2026.

Sidewalks - The committee agreed that sidewalks are a priority for 2026. The town will meet with VDOT representative on April 14th to identify the easements in West Irvington. A member of the committee will prepare a sidewalk report detailing the condition of all sidewalks in the town so we can make a plan for necessary repairs.

There was a conversation about a future town office owned by the town, but there was no consensus on it. It is not a priority for this year.

Motions for the town council meeting:

Committee agreed to recommend purchase of a basketball hoop and tennis backboard for the Commons.
