INITIATING AND REFERRING A ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Potential Ordinance Amendment(s) to Align Town Code with New ADU Law

WHEREAS, Town Council has considered a proposed amendment to the zoning ordinance of the Town of Irvington, Virginia (the “Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Amendment is described as: adjusting language in the town code related to Accessory Dwelling Units to align the town with the Code of Virginia §15.2-2292.3 (also known as the newly passed ADU Law - S 531); and

WHEREAS, the Amendment is proposed to serve the health, safety, welfare and good zoning practices of the Town and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to initiate and refer the matter to the Town Planning Commission for its consideration and recommendation thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Town of Irvington, Virginia does hereby initiate and refer the proposed Amendment to the Town Planning Commission.
