

**TOWN OF IRVINGTON, VIRGINIA
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-17**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF A SURPLUS POLICE VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the Town of Irvington has acquired a replacement vehicle for use in the Town Deputy Program; and

WHEREAS, the existing police vehicle requires substantial repairs, including replacement of the transmission and air conditioning system; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the cost of repairing the vehicle exceeds its practical value to the Town and that the vehicle is no longer suitable for Town operations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council further finds that the vehicle has little or no net value to the Town and should be declared surplus property and disposed of in an appropriate manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council that:

1. The existing police vehicle previously used in the Town Deputy Program is hereby declared surplus property.
2. The Town Administrator is authorized to dispose of the vehicle through salvage, recycling, transfer, scrapping, or any other lawful means determined to be in the best interest of the Town.
3. The Mayor, Town Administrator, and Town Clerk (as applicable) are authorized to execute any documents necessary to complete the disposal of the vehicle on behalf of the Town.
