



Public Safety and Events Committee Meeting Minutes

Thursday, August 20th, 2026, at 5:30 pm at the Town Office

1. Call to Order
The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM.
2. Roll Call
MW Cline, P. Robinson, J. Harris were in attendance
3. Old Business
Updates on previously discussed items were incorporated into New Business.
4. New Business
 - a. Golf Cart Access
 - i. The Committee discussed continued resident interest in expanded golf cart access and better connectivity throughout Town, including possible options involving VDOT and alternative routes within Town.
 - ii. The Committee discussed having the Town Office send an email to residents with registered golf carts to clarify current rules and permitted routes.
 - b. Speed Feedback Signs & Traffic Safety
 - i. The Committee reviewed the proposed speed feedback signs for King Carter Drive and their ability to provide traffic and speed data.
 - ii. The Committee agreed to recommend that Town Council approve the purchase and installation of the proposed speed feedback signs at a cost not to exceed \$10,000.
 - iii. Additional traffic-calming options were discussed as possible future considerations after the speed signs are installed and data is collected.
 - c. Town Street Light Policy
 - i. The Committee discussed resident concerns regarding streetlight brightness and possible options for addressing those concerns.
 - ii. Discussion included seeking additional information from Dominion regarding available lighting options and using that information to help develop parameters for addressing future streetlight concerns.
 - d. Additional Public Safety and Events Priorities
 - i. It was reported that, due to scheduling and band availability, a fall concert will not be held this year and planning will begin for the 2027 Fourth of July celebration.
 - ii. The Committee discussed possible dates for the 2027 Fourth of July parade, including July 5th.
5. Recommendations to Town Council
 - i. The Committee will recommend that Town Council approve moving forward with the proposed speed feedback signs for King Carter Drive, including funding sufficient to cover necessary equipment and installation.
6. Next meeting: The Committee discussed potential September meeting dates. The date will be confirmed after checking committee member availability.
