RESOLUTION 2026-28

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF TWO DRIVER
FEEDBACK SIGNS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE CAPITAL BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Irvington, Virginia (the “Town”), recognizes the importance of promoting safe driving and encouraging compliance with posted speed limits within the Town; and

WHEREAS, excessive vehicle speeds present safety concerns for pedestrians, bicyclists, residents, visitors, and motorists; and

WHEREAS, driver feedback signs provide motorists with immediate information regarding their vehicle speed and serve as an educational and traffic-safety tool to encourage voluntary compliance with posted speed limits and applicable traffic laws; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to purchase and install two driver feedback signs for use within the Town to educate drivers regarding their speed and encourage compliance with posted speed limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Town of Irvington, Virginia, hereby authorizes the Town Administrator to purchase and arrange for the installation of two driver feedback signs for use within the Town.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total cost for the purchase and installation of the two driver feedback signs shall not exceed **Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000)**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the **Capital Budget: Traffic Calming** line item for the purchase and installation of the two driver feedback signs authorized by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Administrator is authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to complete the purchase and installation of the signs, consistent with applicable purchasing requirements and within the expenditure limit authorized by this Resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
